The Taita Hills Wildlife Sanctuary borders Tsavo West, off Voi town. It is a privately owned, largely unfenced protected area consisting of 28,000-acres of semi-permeable terrain which forms part of the greater Tsavo ecosystem. The Sarova Taita Hills Game Lodge & its sister property, the Sarova Salt Lick Game Lodge are only 8km apart.



Sarova Taita Hills Game lodge offers luxury accommodation and amenities that are unsurpassed. The lodge lies within the privately owned Taita Hills Wildlife Sanctuary and provides the ultimate base from which to explore and stands aloft a raised ridge capturing an impressive view of the encompassing hills.

The creeper covered stone buildings bring English country charm to the African plains and here guests will enjoy first class service and facilities in an unforgettable setting. This memorable property also offers a myriad of business and entertainment options with 2 conference rooms capable of sitting 100 participants.

Sarova Taita Hills Game Lodge has 62 beautifully appointed rooms including two suites, swimming pool, spacious lobby, boutique, restaurant, meeting rooms and a conference hall. Accessing both lodges is easy, at just 200km from Mombasa or a gentle 1/2 hour flight from Nairobi. The lodge sits on meticulously kept lawns; the

Located in the heart of the Taita Hills Wildlife Sanctuary is Sarova Salt Lick Game Lodge is truly a unique architectural concept consisting of 96 rooms that are elevated on stilts, each overlooking a waterhole and linked by suspended walkways. As the sun sets with brilliant colours the waterholes are floodlit ensuring that guests have front row seats to the magical show that takes place at sunset.

Thirsty parties consisting of the magnificent elephant, gazelles, buffalo, warthogs, hyenas and baboons slowly appear from the bush to quench their thirst. The lodge also offers a dining experience like no other.

The restaurant, which serves international and local cuisine, has wide tall French windows that ensure that you never miss a moment of the magical show. A beautiful terraced bar commands a spectacular views of the waterhole and surrounding grasslands.

An underground tunnel and chamber was strategically constructed in order to allow guests a closer and safe view of the wildlife at ground level.
