EXCURSIONS AND ACTIVITIES

Kisumu Impala Sanctuary: Set on the shore of Lake Victoria, the largest freshwater lake in Africa, the Kisumu Impala Sanctuary is a peaceful, relaxing place to enjoy the beauty of nature. The sanctuary hosts impalas, the rare Sitatunga antelope as well as big cats, buffalos, giraffes, cheetahs and several primate species. Bird watching, nature walks and glass bottomed boat rides compliment the activities availed at the sanctuary. It is located approximately 3 Kms from Kisumu CBD. *(chargeable)*

Kisumu Museum: Kisumu Museum exhibits focus on the natural and cultural history of Western Kenya. It features a collection of local flora and fauna, as well as a traditional Luo homestead. It is located approximately 3 Kms from Kisumu CBD. *(chargeable)*

Hippo Point: It is an open viewing point for hippos on Lake Victoria. 2 Kilometers from CBD. (*free access*)

Kit Mikayi: It is a large rock formation, with about 3 rocks on top. It is situated approximately 29 kilometres from Kisumu Town. (free access)

Ndere Island National Park: It is an island of serenity and beauty located off the Kisumu- Bondo road. It takes approximately 45 minutes with a speed boat direct from Kisumu. *(chargeable)*

Dunga Beach: It is a popular beach in Kisumu, located on the eastern shores of Lake Victoria. It is known for fishing activities and boat riding. 3 Kilometers from CBD.

Dunga Hill Camp: It is a serene site located on the shores of Lake Victoria that offers a perfect environment for camping, picnics, kayaking, boat riding, hippo watching, bird watching and team building activities. (*free access*)

Art Markets: You can visit the Maasai market located along the Kisumu-Nairobi road. Numerous art pieces, decorations and paintings can be found here. Another famous art market is the Kisumu Art House where a variety of art collections can be found. Approximately 1 Kilometer from the CBD. (free access)
