

REVISED COVID-19 PROTOCOLS



INBOUND AND OUTBOUND TRAVELLERS TO KENYA

- Masks are not mandatory for guests in public spaces however guests are required to have their masks in indoor spaces.
- Guests will no longer be subjected to temperature screening upon entry or in various outlets across all Sarova properties.
- All our hand washing and sanitization stations will remain in place for guests at the entry and designated points throughtout all Sarova properties.
- We encourage all our guests to observe safe distancing during events, particularly indoors/enclosed spaces.
- All our guests who are fully vaccinated shall be exempted from the requirement of PCR tests.
- For inbound guests, quarantine for both vaccinated and unvaccinated guests in no longer required.
- All eligible unvaccinated guests arriving to Kenya must have a negative COVID-19 PCR test results conducted not more than 72 hours before departure.
- Unvaccinated guests arriving at any point of entry into Kenya shall be subjected to rapid antigen test at their own cost.
- All guests arriving at any point of entry into Kenya will be required to fill the passenger locator form on the "Jitenge" platform.
- Guests travelling out of the country will be required to abide by exisiting travel, health and COVID-19 related requirements of the destination country.

We continue to observe all Covid-19 protocols to ensure we provide our guests and staff a safe and secure environment.
